Please Note Gate Code information below.

All vehicles entering the park must have a valid Gate code **SUBVETS22**, or they will be **subject to the standard vehicle entry fee of \$5.00 per vehicle.**

Instructions: Each guest will need to use the pay station at the Richards Blvd entrance to enter the code and receive their parking pass. Upon arriving at the pay station follow the prompts on the screen for #5 "More Selections" then #3 "Coupon Code" then enter the coupon code provided above. The parking pass will be printed and needs to be placed on the dash of each vehicle in your party.
